ROCKLEDGE, FL (May 1, 2024) – Community Credit Union of Florida kicks off Community Heroes Month with a Nominate a Hero Contest and prizes, plus special account offers. This marks the third year for Community Heroes Month, which runs the entire month of May.

Anyone in the community is invited to submit a story about a local hero for the Nominate a Hero Contest via a Survey Monkey [contest link](#). Submissions will be taken through May 31, 2024. Each year many heartfelt stories are submitted explaining how a hero they know has impacted the lives of others or the community. Four stories will be selected and the heroes will be awarded a \$100 VISA® Gift Card and a customized Community Hero Yeti Rambler or Gallon Jug®. They will also be recognized on CCU Florida's social media channels.

To be considered a CCU Florida Community Hero, you must be a first responder, a Pre-K to University level teacher who works in the private or public sector, an employee of any public school in our service area, an employee in the medical field who holds a license or certificate, are active duty, reserve duty or retired military, or work for a legally registered nonprofit agency.

Heroes can take advantage of the following special account offers: 1) Earn up to \$500 in bonuses in a new checking and savings account, and 2) Finance a home with CCU's exclusive Community Hero Loan which offers up to 100% financing and does not require PMI insurance.*
