BE AN INFORMED BUYER.

Conduct thorough inspections.

Once you find a property you like, don't skip the inspection. Hire a qualified home inspector to assess the condition of the property. This can uncover hidden issues and help you make an informed decision.

Be a smart negotiator. Real estate transactions often involve negotiations. Be prepared to adjust

your offer, but also be willing to walk away if the terms aren't favorable. Before signing any documents, pay attention to important details such as contingencies, deadlines, and clauses related to repairs or concessions. Your real estate agent can help you.

STAND OUT WHEN SELLING. Enhance curb appeal. First

impressions matter. Boost your home's curb appeal by maintaining the exterior, landscaping the yard, and making any necessary repairs or upgrades.

Declutter and de-personalize. Remove personal items and excess clutter to help buyers envision themselves living in the home. Consider staging to showcase the property's potential.
